The pages of this section are unnumbered and must be in the following order:

1. Thesis cover in English
2. Blank page
3. In the name of God
4. Title page in English (form number 1)
5. Student declaration form
6. Oath of pharmacist, copy right and ownership
7. Minutes of the defense
8. Dedication (Max 2 pages)
9. Acknowledgements (Max 2 pages)
10. Abstract and keywords (form number 2)
 - Abstract includes: Title, Introduction, Material & Methods, Results, Conclusion, Keywords
 - Be on one page (up to 300 – 500 words)
 - Keywords include: Author keywords (up to 3 – 6), MeSH keywords (up to 3 – 6)
 - Search for MeSH keywords on the [MeSH Online](#)

12. Abbreviations
13. List of Tables
14. List of Figures, Pictures and Maps

Integrated instruction for thesis formatting

Text formatting and adjustment

Each chapter begins with the title of chapter in **times new roman bold 25** font.

- **Margins and line spacing**

Margins for all pages: top and left 3.5 cm / bottom and right 2.5 cm

For quotes : left 4 cm/ right 3.5

Don't use header and border

*If a title is longer than one line, the spacing between the lines should be set to single

- **Font**

	Times new roman
Text body	12
Heading 1	14 bold
Heading 2	13 bold

The text below of tables, pictures and graphs	10

The first line of each paragraph should be one centimeter indented

Integrated instruction for thesis formatting

Write description of tables above them

Write description of pictures and graphs below them

- **Footnote and citation**

Ask the Supervisor or Advisor

- **Mathematical formulas and equations**

Use MS Word Equation. Number it this way (chapter number- Equation number)

- **Units**

Used units must be based on the international standard system of units (SI). If you use different unit , its equivalent in other systems must be write in [] .

- **Title of picture**

Type the title below the picture on the left .Number it this way (chapter number- picture number)

- **Title of table or graph**

Type the title above the table or graph on the left. Number it this way (chapter number- table or graph number)

Notice: if there is an explanation for a table, be sure to include it in the footnote.

- **Numbering**

Insert page number in the middle and the bottom of the page

The pages before chapter one should be numbered with Greek letters (I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X)

The first page of chapter one takes “number 1” and then continues to the end

- Numbering the sections of each chapter

Each section is numbered with 2 numbers. The one on the right is related to chapter and the one on the left represents the section, also the numbers of sub-sections comes after section number

Integrated instruction for thesis formatting

- Numbering the formulas

The first number on the right is related to chapter and the one on the left represents the number of formula in that chapter

- Numbering the appendixes

Appendixes take ordinal number and reference them in the text like: (appendix 3)

- Bibliography

It titled “References” and starts with a separate page from other chapters. The writing pattern is based on Vancouver system

- Thesis cover

The contents of the thesis cover are based on the title pages in Persian and Latin

The contents of the cover of the thesis should be in English with “Times New Roman” font and golden

The contents of the back cover of the thesis should be in Persian with “B Titr” font and golden

The spine of thesis includes title of thesis and student’s full name which are located at a distance of 3 cm from top and down of spine

If the thesis pages exceed 600 pages, it should be printed in two volumes
